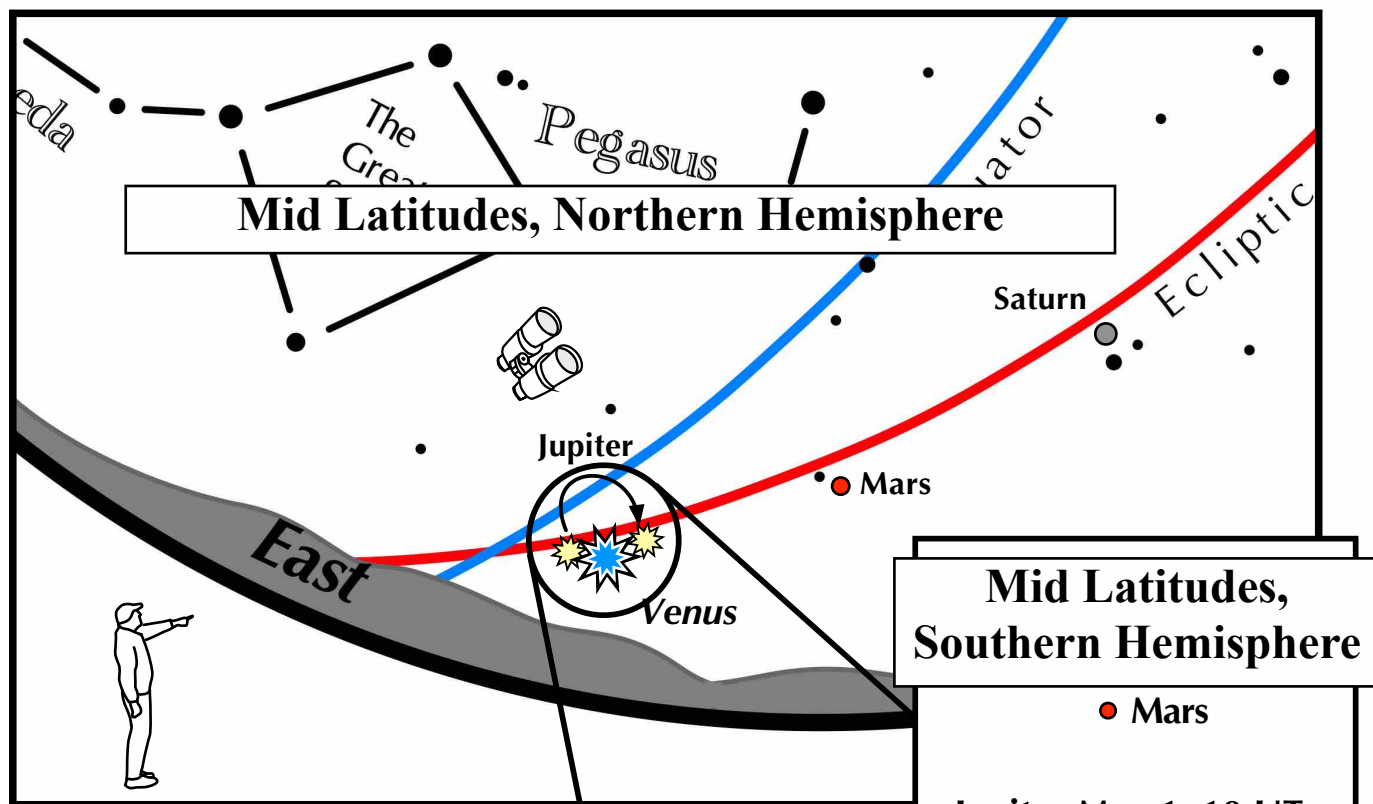


Jupiter Jumps Venus



On the last few mornings of April, look to the east-southeast 60 minutes before sunrise.

- The dazzling object is Venus.
- To its immediate east, shines an object not quite as bright – Jupiter.
- On April 30, 10 UT, Jupiter lies to the east of Venus.
- On April 30, 22 UT, Jupiter lies at its closest to Venus, passing just north of it.
- On May 1 10 UT, Jupiter now sits to its west.

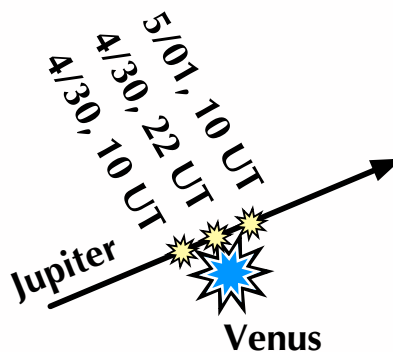
Jupiter May 1, 10 UT
