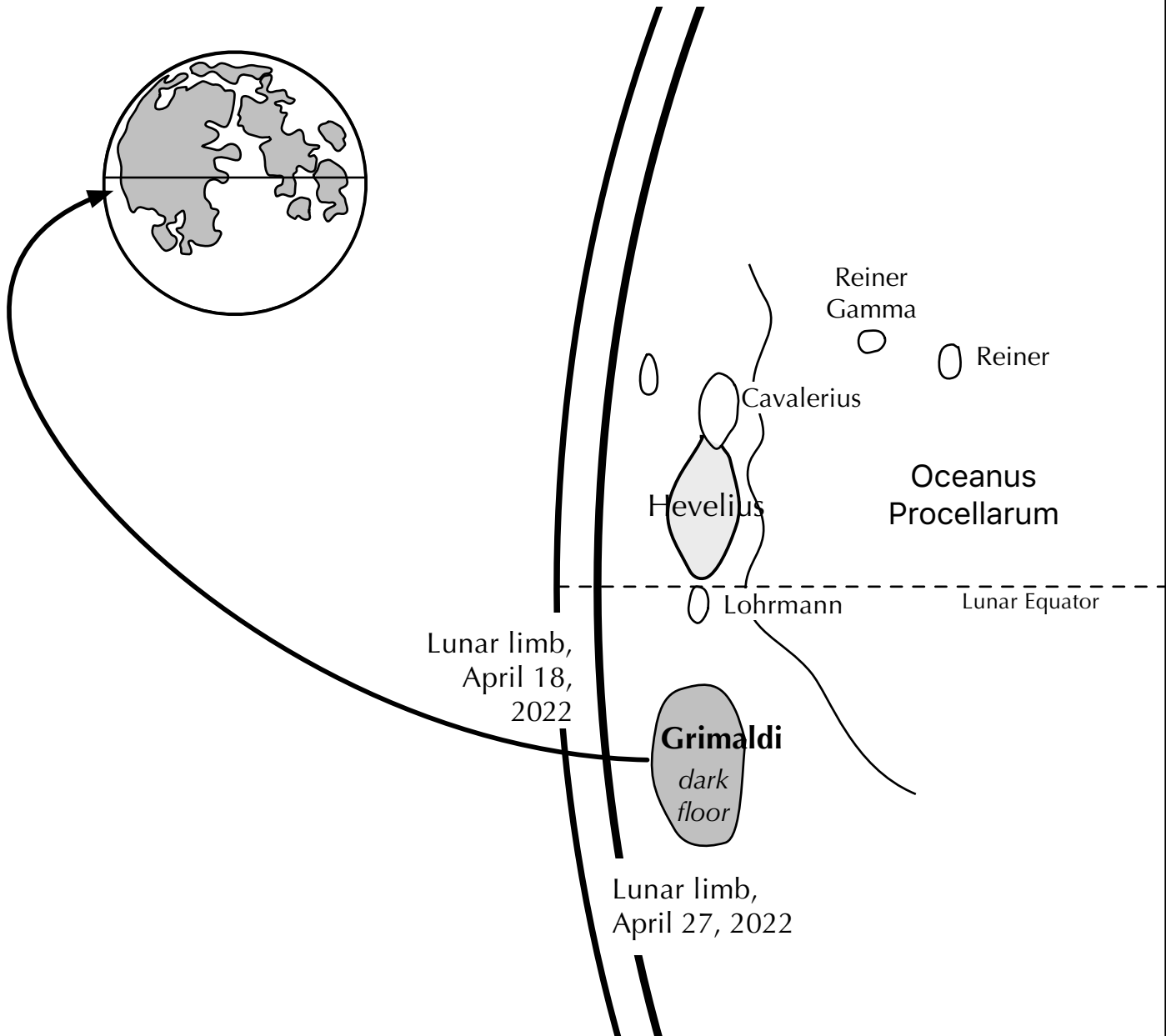




Lunar Western Libration:

near Grimaldi and Hevelius, at the far western edge of Oceanus Procellarum



With binoculars or a small telescope, look just south of the lunar equator along the western edge of the lunar disk for the dark-floored crater, Grimaldi. Note how far it lies from the limb. That distance should noticeably decrease between April 18 and 27.
